Sidney M. and Ruth K. Zirwes Scholarship Application

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible, all candidates must meet the following minimum requirements:

- ***You must be the child, grandchild, or great-grandchild of a 32^o Scottish Rite Mason***
- ***First-time applicants MUST be in the final semester of your senior year of high school with the intention of actively pursuing a post-secondary school education (college, university, vocational, professional)***

In addition, the Scholarship Committee will consider the applicant's academic record, together with participation in activities of school, community, religious, and youth organizations. Lastly, an applicant must clearly establish and demonstrate their need for financial assistance.

All candidates who satisfy the above requirements will compete for a limited number of Sidney M. and Ruth K. Zirwes Scholarships awarded annually. The final selection of scholarship recipients rests with the Wisconsin Scottish Rite Foundation.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE
